

Directions to Central Indiana Land Trust Properties

Blue Bluff State Nature Preserve

From Mooresville: Head south on State Road 67 about 7 miles to Centerton Road. Turn Left and cross the railroad tracks. Take an immediate Right on Blue Bluff Road. After crossing the river, park at a small pull off on the right side of the road. Walk back to the double gate on the Left side of the road. Go through the gate and follow the path along the woods edge up to the top of the bluff. A green sign marks the beginning of Blue Bluff.

Burnett Woods State Nature Preserve

From US-36 in Avon: Head south on Dan Jones Road (County Road 800 East). At the roundabout at County Road 100 South, turn Left. Light and Life Methodist Church will be ahead on your Left. Parking is available here. Walk east from here to property entrance, near the road.

Burr Oak Bend Nature Preserve

From Noblesville: Head north on State Road 37 and turn Left on 206th Street. There are three designated parking areas.

- 1) The first will be just ahead on your Left and is marked by a double gate.
- 2) Cross the river and turn Left on Riverwood Avenue. A designated parking area is ahead on the Left at the original Burr Oak Bend parcel.
- 3) Cross the river and turn Right on Riverwood Avenue. A designated parking area is ahead on the Right, and is marked as a Hamilton County Parks Canoe Launch.

Frank Ratcliff Memorial Forest (2705 W. 70 S., North Vernon, 47265)

From North Vernon: Take US-50 west to County Road 265 West. Turn Left (south). Turn Left at County Road 70 South. Property will be less than a half mile ahead on both sides of the road. A double gate marks an entrance on the north side of the road.

Gene B. Glick Nature Preserve

From the east side of Indianapolis: Take I-70 to the Post Road Exit, and head north on Post Road. Turn Right on 42nd Street. Gene B. Glick Nature Preserve will be on your Left just before Mitthoeffer Road.

Hajji Hollow Nature Preserve (4133 W. US Highway 36, Rockville, 47872)

From intersection of US-41 and US-36 in Rockville: Head west on US-36 about 4.3 miles. Turn Left onto the gravel lane just before the Midway Apartments, at a post marked 4133. Property is ahead past the creek crossing.

Hemlock Ridge State Nature Preserve

From US-36 at the Hendricks/Putnam County line: Take County Line Road north to County Road 1100 North (marked only on the Left side of the road). Turn Left. Road will jog south then quickly back north again. A designated parking area is on the Right side just before home at 7201 E. County Road 1100 North.

Jacob Schramm Nature Preserve

From Interstate 70: Take Mount Comfort Exit and head south. Property will be on your Right just before County Road 200 South. There is a designated parking area.

John Sunman's Woods

From Interstate 74 in Ripley County: Take Exit 156 and head south to State Road 46. Turn Right on State Road 46 and follow to County Road 775 East. Turn Right. Sunman's Woods will be on your Left side, at the northwest corner of this intersection.

Millard Sutton/Amos W. Butler Audubon Sanctuary

This property is not open for visitation due to the fragility of the Great Blue Heron nesting area.

Mossy Point State Nature Preserve

From intersection of US-41 and US-36 in Rockville: Head north on US-41 about 6.5 miles to Annapolis Road (County Road 625 North). Turn Left. Follow through several turns to a stop sign. Go straight through the stop sign and onto the gravel road. As soon as the gravel road veers south, turn Right onto gravel drive at mailbox marked 5922. Sign for Mossy Point will be through the gate and ahead on your Right.

Sanctuary Oaks Nature Preserve

From US-41 in Shelburn: Head west on State Road 46 (West Polk Street). At County Road 200 West, turn Left. Sanctuary Oaks will be on your Left, at the southeast corner of 200 West and 650 North.

Shalom Woods Nature Preserve

From Mooresville: Head south on State Road 67 about 5 miles. Turn Right on Observatory Road and go up the hill. Parking is available at a small pull off next to a double gate on your Right side. The property starts is on the other side of the gate.

Wapihani Nature Preserve

From Interstate 69 and 116th Street in Fishers: Head west on 116th Street about 3 miles to Eller Road. The property is on the southwest corner of 116th Street and Eller Road. Public parking is available behind Riverside Middle School (10910 Eller Road) or for one or two cars at the end of Trails End Road (just west of the property).
